To book tickets this year we have made the system a lot simpler for all involved. This year you will book and pay for your tickets on Eventbrite all in one go. You will only need the names and dates of birth and photo consent of your group for booking. We have a booking form on our website for you to print off and give to your young people so that you have all the information you need to bring them to May Camp 2020.

(You will receive this nearer to camp, we'll ask you how many tents you're bringing so we can calculate the size of your pitch.)

MORE INFO

*** play old videos, use the songs from the worship team, talk about the expectations of camp, share testimonies from previous years.*

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If you have extra people who want to come with you then you simply head to the website and buy more tickets.

Make sure you are using the website tools to keep your young people excited about May Camp 2020, ** and look out for the Hoodie Pre Order form!

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Buy your May Camp 2020 Hoodie before you get to camp and collect them at Info Point when you register!

Make sure everyone has a packing list! This can be found on our website.

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Plan your menus and the people who are preparing/bringing you food. **THEY NEED A TICKET TOO!**

Free tickets are available for people who will be coming onsite to drop food. Please go to Eventbrite and use the option for dropping food or children on site!

Download a copy of the programme before May Camp so you can see what things are happening!

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Print off your tickets or get the QR code ready on your phone to show at the gate on arrival.

CAMP TIME

Get to camp and have your ticket/QR code ready to show security on the gate as you arrive

Find your patch on site and get your people to unpack and set up camp!

Youth Leaders come to Info Point with tickets for your group. When you get there your tickets will be swapped for wristbands and registers will be checked to make sure everyone has arrived. This needs to be done by 5pm before your FREE Hog Roast. Exceptions can apply please contact youth@chichester.anglican.org

At Info Point, you will receive all the information you need to for May Camp 2020 and any Hoodies you pre-ordered.

May Camp 2020 Hoodies will also be available for Sale at £20 from Info Point over the weekend.

Please remember that anyone coming for the day or coming onsite with food or to collect/drop children will need their ticket either printed or on a screen. They will not get past security without it!

Day visitors will also need to get a wristband from info point.

If delivering food, you will need to park in the car park and walk to your group (get help from your young people if needed)

PACKING LIST FOR YOUTH LEADERS

- Tents (enough to sleep everyone, together with space to store food, cook etc. and ground sheets)
- Fire bucket (if you're bringing a tent)
- Mallets
- Pegs
- Guy lines (including spares)
- Chemical toilets & tents for night use
- Chemical toilet fluids
- Washing up bowls
- Washing up liquid
- Tea towels
- Soap for hands!
Towel (to be left near each toilet)
- Toilet paper
- Disinfectant
- Disposable gloves
- Camping Gas
- Cooker
- Gas cylinders (plus
- Matches
- Fire bucket/ extinguisher for EACH TENT. It is vitally important that you provide one bucket per tent
- Water containers for 'Drinking' and 'Waste'. Please bring some large and some smaller containers for your drinking water. All containers must be clearly labelled with the name of your group
- Saucepans (depending on what you will be cooking!)
- Kettle
- Cutlery
- Plates
- Bowls
- Mugs
- Freezer box
- Ice packs
- First Aid Kit
- Clothes line/Pegs,
- Rubbish sacks
- Torch
- Batteries
- Chairs and tables
- Food for the weekend

Group members will need to bring:

- Wellingtons or stout shoes
- Wet weather gear
- Change(s) of clothes
- Sleeping bag, lilo or foam mat
- Warm night clothes
- Bible, notebook and Pen
- Torch
- Plastic bags for dirty clothes
- Money for bookstall & café
- Suncream

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
