Good to know...

Registration

When you arrive, your group leader will register you at the Info Point. All day visitors must also register as soon as they arrive.

When you register, you'll recieve a wristband. This must be worn at all times when on-site. Please look after your wristband - a replacement costs £5.

Security

Anyone arriving or leaving the Maycamp site must see the security guard at the gate. This allows us to keep a record of people and vehicles that are present on site.

BBQ's

BBQs are permitted but must be set up a safe distance from any tents and walkways. They must always be manned by a leader and extinguished properly after use. Please take care not to scorch any grass.

First Aid

If you need first aid or require any other asistance across the weekend, our Info Point team will be able to assist you.

Parking

All vehicles need to be moved to the car park by the start of the first main session on Friday night.

Footwear

For your own safety, footwear must be worn at all times when on the fields or in any of the venues.


Recycling & Waste


